Comox Valley Airport Volunteer Host Program

A great big THANK YOU to all of you!!! What an amazing group you are, such dedication to the airport and our community. You drive here in all types of weather, sometimes only to find the flights have been cancelled, and show up during this new wave of COVID. We really appreciate you! A reminder; we encourage you to check for any flight changes before you head in for your shift.

The airport enhancement project is progressing. The Ops office has been temporarily relocated upstairs in the CVAC lunch room. The old office will become two rooms, the Ops supply room and behind that will be the CATSA secondary screening room. The entrance to the cargo room and baggage screening is now located near the bottom of the stairs by the Pacific Coastal counter.

We now have COVID-19 testing available on site. Passengers requiring a negative COVID test for travel can now book with Connectus Global. Hours are currently M-F, 8 am-noon. Starting on Monday, hours will be 8-4, 7 days a week. There is a link on our website for information about the company. People can book an appointment on-line or by phone. A test collection site has been set up in the belt 2 area by the international arrival doors.

COVID tests for personal use are available in the vending machine and at the gift shop. At this time, these tests are not acceptable for travel.
